

## INFECTIOUS CONTROL POLICY

### Overview

To ensure Powerhouse has best practice to ensure employees and contractors health and wellbeing now and for their futures.

To prevent occupational illness and injury we identify and assess risk factors, manage their impact, and monitor the health status of our people. We also manage work related injury or illness and support our workforce to be mentally and physically healthy to prevent long term impact.

### Process for Dealing with Suspected and/or Confirmed Cases.

Medical assessment from a qualified professional should be obtained as soon as possible to confirm presence of infection. Where a person is assessed to be suffering from viral infection, that person should be isolated from others and isolation precautions should be taken. These include quarantine of the person from public areas.

Common preventative actions for hygiene practices:

- Frequent HANDWASHING with soap and water and following the correct technique is the most important thing an individual can do.
- Avoid touching one's mouth or nose unnecessarily.
- Use and dispose of tissues immediately; and
- Observing hygiene practices of the highest standards when performing their daily tasks and actions.
